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School Advisory Council (SAC)

Every school is required to have a School Advisory Council (SAC) and School Advisory Forum (SAF). The School Advisory Council is a school-based group intended to represent the school, the community and those closest to the students. The group shares responsibility for guiding the school towards continuous improvement. The School Advisory Council is responsible for final decision making at the school relating to the provisions of the annual School Improvement Plan (SIP).

School Advisory Forum (SAF)

The goal of the School Advisory Forum is to improve the education experience through advocacy, communication, and partnerships between Parents, Schools, and the Broward County School District. SAF meets throughout the school year, often after our SAC meetings, and representatives attend the district North Area Advisory Council meetings. The topics discussed are often district wide initiatives, such as school safety, student well-being, calendars and community issues.

Serving on the SAC or SAF requires monthly attendance at meetings. SAC-SAF meetings are held on the first Tuesday of every month beginning at 2pm, and two evening meetings per school year. We hope that you will consider joining these important groups.
