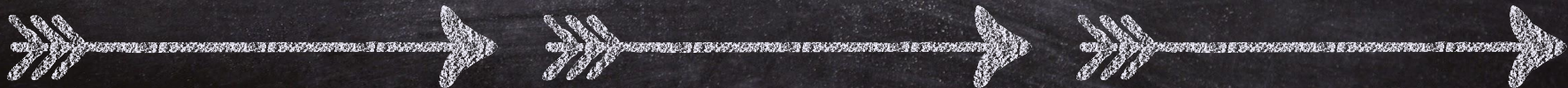

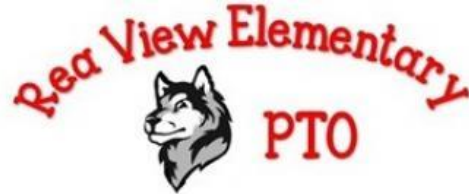

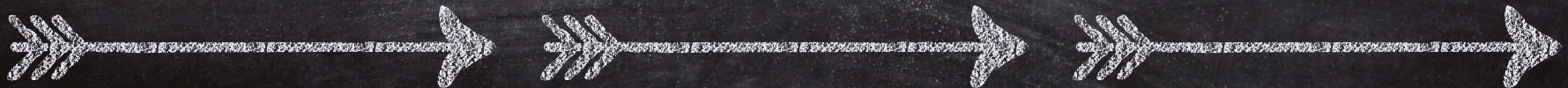




PTO Mission

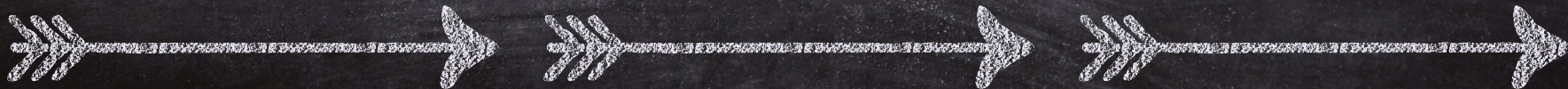
2022-23 PTO Year in Review

- Purchased organizing shelves for PTO office

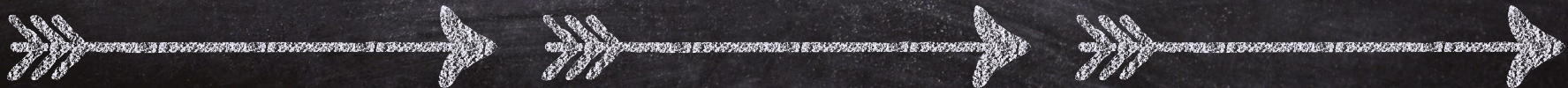

Student Services Committee

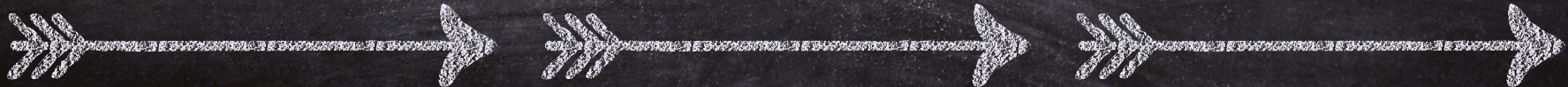

Staff Services Committee

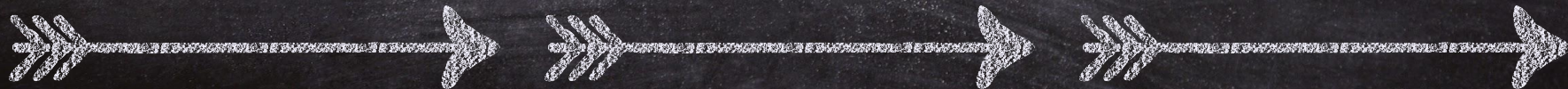
- **Back to school welcome luncheon** catered by Burtons grill

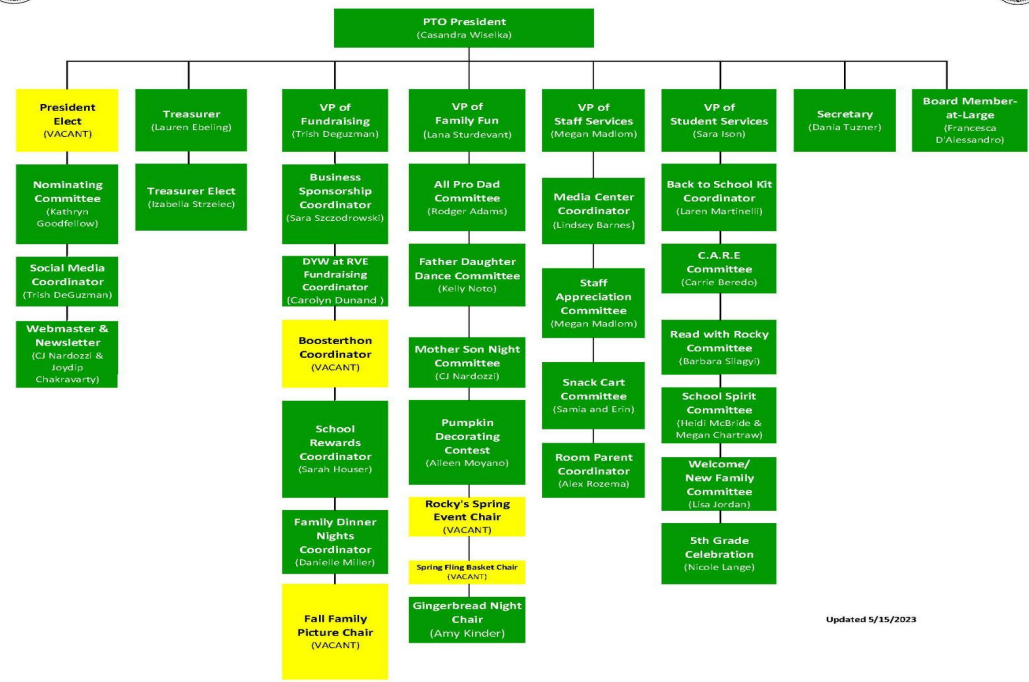

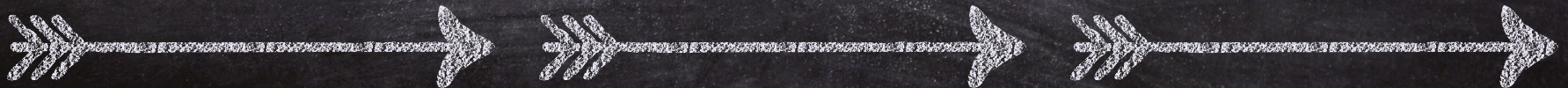

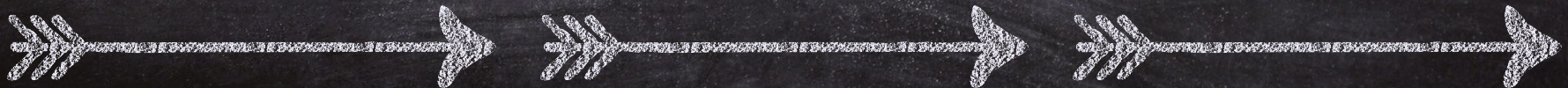
