Attention, parents of **juniors!** The PSAT/NMSQT will be given at Spanish River High School on **Thursday, October 26, 2023. This test is NOT mandatory for juniors**, but we would like to offer the opportunity to any 11th grader who would like to participate. The fee is \$25 and will need to be paid via School Cash Online. Information for how to pay and sign up has been emailed to your student and posted in your child's English teacher's Google Classroom. Please note that the registration process is two steps - first, the payment, then the registration via Google Form. Both steps must be completed for your registration to be valid. **The deadline to sign up is TONIGHT at 11:59 PM** on Sunday, September 10, 2023. Please note that, due to our ordering deadlines, late registrations cannot be accepted.

Important Testing Updates: Students and parents, **if your child has not successfully completed the ELA or Math requirements for graduation or would like to earn the Scholar Diploma designation** please take note of the following information:

- FAST ELA test** September 12th (Media center 7:30am)
***11th & 12th grades students only.
- **BEST Algebra EOC** September 13th (Media Center 7:30am)
- **FSA ELA- 12th grade students only** September 18th-20th-- this is a three day test.
- **FSA Algebra EOC-** September 21st-22nd this is a two day test.
- Make up testing will be the week of September 26th.

Additionally, in regards to testing, students seeking the **Scholar Diploma** designation please note that **you must have completed the course in order to take the exam.** If you have, please fill out the [Scholar Diploma Designation](#) Google Form to sign up for the specific exam you need to take.
