The **Pathfinder Scholarship Awards**, which are presented by the Palm Beach Post, are presented each year to high school seniors in Palm Beach and Martin counties who demonstrate outstanding achievement in one of the following 18 categories: academic excellence, art, business, career/technical education, communications, community involvement, computer engineering/technology, forensics/speech, history/political science, literature, mathematics, music/instrumental, music/vocal, reach for excellence, science, sports, theater arts, and world language. Each high school in Palm Beach and Martin Counties may submit only one nominee per category. The scholarship winners receive cash awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. The nomination forms will be available beginning Tuesday, **October 17, 2023** in both student Suites (Silver and Blue) as well as posted to our school's website.

Attention **Juniors and Seniors - National Honor Society** applications are available via Google Form on Google Classroom (11th and 12th grade teachers). Eligible students meeting the following criteria will be considered: 3.5 GPA or 3.8 HPA, at least 50 logged hours of community service, and no discipline referrals.
