Second Nine Weeks is winding down and we will soon begin reviewing for semester exams. Please review this email in its entirety to ensure you understand what review opportunities are being offered for our **IMPORTANT** district semester exams.

Important testing note - **ELA Retakes** are upon us again. We will be testing any Junior or Senior that has not met graduation requirements in either ELA. ELA testing will take place tomorrow, Monday, December 4th. Like math testing from this past week, the ELA testing will start after first period. We have attached the students' locations for your review.

**Semester Exams** will take place the week of December 18th. The schedule is attached for you to review. Semester Exams are extremely important to a student's final semester grade or yearly final grade (EOC courses). District semester exams count for a large portion of the final yearly grade and it is important that all students in EOC courses take their exams before the holidays as they are excellent preparation for the actual EOC in the Spring. We will be offering some semester exam prep sessions after school so please stay tuned and be on the lookout for important ParentLink emails from teachers around these important prep sessions (Algebra, Biology, Geometry, and US History) If your child is sick then he/she should reach out to their teacher to schedule a make-up exam session. No exams can be taken before the exam window begins. Again, students should work with their teachers if they have conflicts or concerns.

If you have taken a **Cambridge Exam** in past years, and want to retake an exam during the **June 2024 Exam Series**, please review the form, posted on the Cambridge Grade Level Google Classrooms, and is attached to the written portion of this callout, in its entirety and follow **ALL** of the directions precisely. Please be sure you are aware of the exact deadline of Friday, January 12, 2024 and note there are **NO EXCEPTIONS** to this deadline.

Please note that this is **NOT** for students who will take a Cambridge Exam for the first time during the June 2024 Exam Series.
