Congrats to the Spanish River High School community for receiving an "A" rating for 2023. SRHS continues to be the TOP performing comprehensive high school in Palm Beach County. We are so proud of our amazing staff and students that worked hard to earn this recognition.

Semester Exams will take place the week of Monday, December 18. The schedule is attached for you to review. Semester Exams are extremely important to a student's final semester grade or yearly final grade (EOC courses). District semester exams count for a large portion of the final yearly grade and it is important that all students in EOC courses take their exams before the holidays as they are excellent preparation for the actual EOC in the Spring. If your child is sick then he/she should reach out to their teacher to schedule a make-up exam session. No exams can be taken before the exam window begins. Again, students should work with their teachers if they have conflicts or concerns.

We are excited to share with you that two of our River students, **Chase Turmail** and **Marvin Gao**, have been invited to participate in the **American Invitational Mathematics Examination (AIME)**. Back in November, 10 River students took the AMC 10 and 12 test (American Mathematics Competition for 10th and 12th grades and under). The AIME is by invitation only. Based on their scores, **Marvin and Chase** have received an invitation to participate in the AIME in February. Invitation is made to students with scores in the top 5% of the AMC 12 and the top 2.5% of the AMC 10 nationally. The AIME is intended to provide further challenge and recognition to high school students who have exceptional mathematical ability.
