Course Selection for FY25 has begun. The course selection process will be explained in English classes. Please speak with your child in regards to their choice of electives for next year. Your child will visit the theater soon with counselors to choose their electives for FY25. All core classes will be chosen by teachers and administration. Please check your email as emails are sent out separate from the callout. Core teachers will use current grades, prior grades, and test scores to place students in core classes and academic (AICE and AP) electives. Administration will revisit all course placements in the Spring and Summer when NEW test scores come in for this year and will make adjustments accordingly. Please reach out to your child's counselor if you have any questions. Counselor assignments are on our website.

On **Thursday, March 7th, 2024**, Spanish River High School will administer the **School Day SAT** for **all 11th grade students and select 12th graders**. All 11th graders and select 12th grade students who still need to meet the ELA or math graduation requirements are automatically pre-registered for this exam. There is NO fee for this exam. **SAT School Day** provides schools, districts, and states a way to offer the official SAT to juniors in school, on a weekday, expanding access to a globally recognized college admission test that's accepted at all U.S. colleges. **Students will be in the testing block from 7:30am-2:50pm.** Students who are not testing will be in a holding room during this time. Following testing, students will go to lunch and then on to 7th period. For SAT testing on Thursday, March 7th we will operate on an altered bell schedule. Any students on campus that are not testing will be in a holding room. There will be 3 early release times. Student's dismissal color will be listed on the testing location sheet. **If students prefer to go home following testing, this Blue Pass Google Form MUST be filled out no later than 8:00 PM on Wednesday, March 6th. Students will not be released before 1:00 PM, and students testing in extended time rooms will likely go past 1pm.**

On **Saturday February 17th**, River's two aerial drone teams competed at a local competition at Don Estridge High Tech Middle School. River is the first Palm Beach county high school to have an aerial drone competition team. Although the teams just started practicing in January, the **two teams were able to secure 2nd place and 7th place over all out of 9 teams competing** (including teams from Don Estridge, Sagemont in Westin, and a group of teams from Bradenton, FL).

The River team of **Logan Damle, Adam Siegel, and Kyle Vilme** won 2nd place. The team also earned the "Inspire" and "Skills" Awards for having the best Skills Field competition score and the best teamwork competition score. They had the highest scores in 2 categories: teamwork (by over 20 points) and in piloting skills (by over 40 points). Their overall scores qualified them to compete at the southeast regional competition in Jackson, Mississippi in April. The River team of **Joshua Gurman, Kai Gao, Max Rispler, and Jessica Strizik** had the highest (by over 25 points) Autonomous Flight score where the team worked to program the drone to fly through an obstacle course, earning points for flying through and looping keyhole and archway obstacles.

Team members **Marvin Gao and Sophia Marchalleck** were not able to attend the competition but contributed greatly to the preparation over the past 6 weeks. The two teams will next compete in mid-March. Participation in this competition was made possible due to a GoTeach! Grant from the Palm Beach County EdFoundation award to Maura Sullivan and Mary Fish.

Congratulations to senior **Helena Parada**, senior **Alexandre Dorcil**, and sophomore **Talia Avivi** for their outstanding performance this weekend at the **Southern Region ACDA Honor Choir in Louisville, KY**. These students were selected by audition as some of the finest singers from the 11 states in the region. Way to go Sharks!

Congrats to our **Girls Tennis Team** on their win over American Heritage last week. This week our Girls host the ladies from Palm Beach Central. Match time is 3:30.

The **Spanish River Wrestling** team competed at the Regional Tournament placing 9th out of 31 teams.
