Attention to 9th and 10th grade parents and students - the two grades will be taking the B.E.S.T Writing Exam on **Thursday, April 4th**. The test will start at 7:30 am. Please make sure you bring a **FULLY CHARGED, SCHOOL-ISSUED** computer with you for the test. All students have had the opportunity to be issued a computer. Please make sure your computers are working before the day of the test. If your computer is not working, please bring it to the technology room 1-153A to get it repaired or to be issued a replacement. We also want to remind you to bring your student ID when you come for the test - it is a requirement to have it on you and visible when you enter the testing room. Anyone without an ID will be asked to go get a new one. Please review the student location that has been sent out and posted in their Google Classroom to know where you are going the day of the test. **Attached to this callout is a copy of the altered bell schedule for the day.**

Attention all **prospective National Honor Society members** - the Spring 2024 application link for Spanish River's National Honor Society can be found on the school website under Honor Societies. The **application due date is April 15, 2024**. No exceptions. Eligible students meeting the following criteria will be considered:

- 3.5 GPA or 3.8 HPA
- at least 50 logged hours of community service
- no discipline referrals.
- Once a member, students will be required to participate in drives and events, offer peer tutoring during lunch, and continue to be an exemplary student.

****IMPORTANT**** Graduating students in the **Class of 2024** who are expecting to earn their **AICE Diploma in June 2024** will receive their results on **August 13, 2024** using their login and password they will receive on the last day of the last exam they take. **By August 20, 2024, Cambridge will send the Bright Futures office an updated list of successful AICE Diploma candidates from the June 2024 series.**

Typically, the **Bright Futures office** will process all information from Cambridge within two weeks of receipt. A student's scholarship status will then be updated in a database accessed by Florida colleges and universities for calculating tuition fees due on the last day of registration drop/add. If necessary, students can tell the financial aid office at their university that they are a pending AICE Diploma graduate and request a deferment on their fall tuition due date.

Please note, **Cambridge cannot send a list of AICE Diploma recipients before the end of a student's senior year.** The Bright Futures office does not attach eligibility information to a student's record until they receive a final high school transcript showing that the student has completed high school. As a reminder, the student must complete the Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA). Additionally the student's final transcript must include their completed community service or work hours as required by the Florida DOE for the Florida Academic Scholars Award as well as their graduation date. The **Bright Futures** application is open! Please apply now at www.floridastudentfinancialaidsg.org/. **All high school seniors** must submit a complete application no later than August 31 of their graduating year. Please note that students receiving the AICE diploma must still complete the online application and 100 hours of community

service to be eligible. Students who do not complete an application will forfeit their eligibility for a Bright Futures scholarship.

Students are encouraged to complete the application even if they are planning to attend an out-of-state school or if they are not planning to attend a postsecondary institution immediately after high school graduation. If eligible, students may receive funding for up to five years from their high school graduation. We also encourage all seniors to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible. The FAFSA is used to determine eligibility for a variety of aid: federal, state, and school-based, as well as grants and scholarships. Please visit Studentaid.gov to begin the FAFSA application. Please contact your student's school counselor with any questions.
