**Graduating Seniors and families-**You will receive this call/email a few more times until the end of this school year. You will then come off our Parent Link as we pick up next year's students. We wish all our graduating students the BEST and look forward to hearing about their future success.

This was a huge week for Shark Nation:

- We celebrated the commencement of the LARGEST graduating class in our school's history, awarding 685 students their diplomas!
- Our very own Ms. Nayyat Bogosyan was honored by the prestigious Dwyer Awards this past Tuesday night by placing within the top three in the high school teachers category.
- And four students were honored by the 2024 Pathfinder Winners
  - **Brooke Taylor** took first place in the "Reach for Excellence" category

While we are beginning to wind down the testing season, there are still some very important tests upcoming. A few general reminders as we begin this next week of testing:

- Both the **Algebra** and **Geometry EOC** will both be held *tomorrow, Monday, May 20th*. The school will be in a testing block ALL DAY. All students who are scheduled for these EOCs or AP/AICE testing must report, however, students that are not involved in either an EOC, makeup EOC, any AP or AICE testing, or students that are completed the day's testing will be placed in a full day holding room.
- **EVERY STUDENT TAKING THE ALGEBRA AND GEOMETRY EOC MUST BRING THEIR FULLY CHARGED CHROMEBOOK OR DISTRICT DEVICE TO SCHOOL FOR TESTING.**
- **If you would like your child dismissed AFTER an exam is over because you've decided that it is okay for them to miss their other classes, you MUST fill out the Google Form posted in that course's Google Classroom by their teacher.** By completing the early release Google Form for testing (located at the end of this section of the callout), you are stating that your child may be released from school once they have been dismissed from their AP/AICE/EOC exam. If you have more than one child, this form must be completed for each child. **This Google Form is NOT for non-testers.** Same procedures follow for non-testers to leave campus, parents call their alpha suite and students pick up passes and leave at bell changes. Students listed with approval to leave campus after the exam will receive a dismissal pass on the day of the test. It will either be given to them at the end of their test session if possible OR they may pick it up from their Suite. Suite Blue (Last Name A-K) or Suite Silver (Last Name L-Z). **This form MUST be completed for each day that you are requesting to have your child released after their test.** Filling out the form once does NOT allow the students to be released for multiple days. Forms MUST be filled out by 5 PM each day the day before testing (starts Monday afternoon for Tuesday's test).

Students taking either **AP or AICE exams** on these days **MUST** take their AP or AICE exams that day. Please check school emails for dates, time, and locations for make-up exams. Keep in mind - **EOCs are 30% of a student's final grade** in the course and should be taken very seriously. Attached below are links to our parent testing calendar; this calendar includes dates for other tests. On the select days mentioned above, all students that are not testing and are on campus will be held in a holding room until testing is complete.

In addition to the EOC/AP/AICE testing ongoing, we also have our final exam week approaching. Our final exams will be given on the following dates:

- Period 6 exam will be given on Friday, May 24.
  - Period 1/2 exams will be given on Tuesday, May 28.
  - Period 3/4 exams will be given on Tuesday, May 29.
  - Period 5/7 exams will be given on Tuesday, May 30.
- *NOTE - May 28-30 are half days. The bell schedule is attached to this callout.*
  - **FOR TUESDAY 5/28, WEDNESDAY 5/29, and THURSDAY 5/30 - no book bags will be allowed on campus. Students will need to be able to carry the items they need for exams by hand.**

An honorable mention on the USAJMO exam means that Marvin scored just outside the top 24 ninth and tenth graders in the United States and Canada. This puts Marvin in the top 1% of all ninth and tenth grade math students in both countries. Congratulations to Marvin on a stellar Math Competition season!
